
Motivation and Values



A person's 'world view' typically combines values from several belief systems, where one is dominant and perhaps two others shade or influence the decisions and choices of the person. The Sandar Values Model, based on Robert Dilts work, illustrates the hierarchy of effects and increasing difficulty of influencing change as interventions move from' results' toward 'values'. We believe values are context sensitive.
